**What:** AORAKI SECONDARY SCHOOLS BADMINTON TOURNAMENT

**When:** Wednesday 31<sup>st</sup> August ( Boys) and Thursday 1<sup>st</sup> September ( Girls)

**Venue:** S.B.S. Events Centre, Morgans Rd, Timaru

**Format:**

There is no change to the format from last year. An indication to the three ability level groups is:

- Section A Good year 11-13s and very good year 9-10s.
- Section B Weak 11-13s and good year 9-10s.
- Section C Remaining year 9-10s.

There is a limit of 24 teams in the tournament this year so be in quick with your entry.

Games will be the first to 21 points or the score at the end of 10 minutes of play.

The final of the top section will be the best of 3 sets.

Feather shuttles will be used for section A only. Plastic shuttles will be used for other grades. Play will be continuous throughout the day so **players should bring their lunch.**

**Managers Meeting:** Will be at 8:45am both days.
