

## Aoraki Secondary School Road Cycling Championships 2012 General Information

**To:** T.I.C. of Cycling,

**Where-**Levels Raceway, Timaru. (Go along Pleasant Point Highway; turn right at the white shed, Levels Raceway sign. Take the first turn left go along for about one and half km and you can't miss it on your right.)

**When** Thursday 9th May, (pp Thursday 17<sup>th</sup> May)

**Postponement.** Listen to Classic Hits 99FM and Port FM by 7a.m. **PLEASE ensure T.I.C's cell phone # is on ENTRY FORM so txt postponement can be swift & direct.**

**Entries & Entry Fee:** \$15.00 per Cyclist (Pay on the day when collecting Race Bib No.)

Late entries will be accepted at the discretion of the Event Coordinator Brent Coe.

ENTRIES due on or before Friday 4<sup>th</sup> May 2012.

**Protests.** These must be lodged within ten minutes of completion of the race. This must be in writing with a \$20.00 fee and lodged with the tournament controller and RSD. This will be reimbursed if the protest is upheld.

**Managers Meeting** 8.40 a.m. in the Club rooms at the raceway.

**Race Start Time** 9.30 a.m Individual Time Trial

**Tents** Schools can erect sun shades or tents on the grass, right hand side of Pit Lane.

**Gearing** Maximum Gear All Riders on a roll out of 6.610 metres. Students to report to the Pitt Area (Pit Lane is to the left of the lane) at 9a.m. All bikes will be checked. Must be two brakes. Race bibs issued when bikes checked at gearing and \$15 paid.

**Invitational Riders:** - Outside schools are welcome to participate in teams and as individuals but are not able to be medal winners. Certificates may either be presented on the day to acknowledge achievements or posted to those respective visitor schools.

**Medals:-** medals will be awarded for the first 3 places.

**Event Format** **Individual Time Trial** (1 lap)

**Scratch Race** (start approximately 10.45)

Year 9/10 Girls 5 laps (12km)

Year 9/10 Boys 5 laps (12km)

Year 11/12/13 Girls 5 laps (12km)

Year 11/12/13 Boys 8 laps (19.2km)

**Yr 11,12,13 Boys Scratch Race is now a Points Race!**

**SPRINTS EVERY LAP**

**1<sup>st</sup> = 5 pts, 2<sup>nd</sup> = 3 pts, 3<sup>rd</sup> = 2pts, 4<sup>th</sup> = 1pt.**

**If a draw at the end of races there will be a count back of placings.**

**School Teams Event (start approximately 1p.m.)**

**Three riders per team**

Year 9/10 Girls 2 laps (4.8km)

Year 9/10 Boys 2 laps (4.8km)

Year 9/10 Mixed, Year 11/12/13 Girls, Year 11/12/13 Mixed

Year 11/12/13 Boys 2 laps (4.8km)

All students report to the start line.

If a team is mixed with a junior and senior student they must race in the senior event. NO composite teams will be allowed. 3 rider teams must start and 3 riders must finish from the same school. Times will be taken from the wheel of the last rider.

**Race briefing** will be held before each race. Students must line up five minutes before their race is due to start. Ten minutes will be allowed between the juniors and seniors for when they line up to start.

**Points** will be awarded as follows:

1<sup>st</sup>-3 points

2<sup>nd</sup>-2 points

3<sup>rd</sup>-1 point.

**The school with the most points is the overall cup winner.**

**Lunch** 12.30-1p.m approximately depending on entries. Students to bring their own lunch and refreshments.

**First Aid** **Schools are responsible for their own.** In an emergency we will ring 111.

**Prize Giving** To be held immediately after the event in the club rooms.  
Certificates, cup and prizes will be awarded.

**N.B. Aero Handle Bars ONLY acceptable in Time Trials!**
